

# Hunt Correctional Center

## I. **Goals:**

To provide a comprehensive educational experience for Forensic Psychiatry Fellows focusing on psychiatric subspecialty knowledge in the treatment of mentally disordered offenders and other inmates in a correctional setting.

## II. **Objectives:**

Elayn Hunt Correctional Center and Tulane University have developed a clinical setting to meet the above educational goal for Forensic Psychiatry Fellows. The Fellows will accompany Tulane faculty at least two hours per week for six months per year to the facility in an experience to provide:

1. Direct clinical experience, including forensic evaluations and treatment of offenders spanning a broad range of age groups and mental disorders,
2. Direct supervision didactic training by Tulane faculty.

Specific objectives to accomplish the above stated goals include:

1. Clinical experience in evaluation and treatment of individuals in correctional settings.
2. Training in Louisiana law related to corrections.
3. Direct formal supervision by trained forensic psychiatrists and psychologists concerning clinical and educational issues in correctional psychiatry.

Fellows will be evaluated based on the satisfactory accomplishment of the objectives and will be given immediate feedback
